Greetings from Delta Junction, Alaska. How wonderful it is to know we serve a risen Saviour. Thank you so much for all your prayers and support. We thank the Lord for His goodness and mercy as He has supplied to meet our needs and given grace during recent physical struggles.

We appreciate all your prayers for Jonathan. We praise the Lord that he is now coming to church on Sundays and Wednesdays. We also meet together at least once a week for about 2 hours for Bible study. He confesses to know the Lord as his Saviour, but struggles with things he was taught in the past. He has a true desire to walk with the Lord. Please continue to pray for him, as well as for me as I minister to Him.

I see Michael occasionally but have observed no changes with him. I continue to give him tracts, talk with him about eternity and remind him that God loves him and that Jesus died for him. He says, "I know" but then changes the subject. Please continue to pray for him.

We visited a lady the other day, as we often do, to encourage her and see how she is doing. She asked questions about the Sabbath and a Bible lesson that I gave her the previous week from Colossians 2:18-23 entitled "Beware of Man-made Disciplines". I explained to her using Scriptures about the Sabbath. She then shared with us about all the religions she has been a part of over the years.
