Hello from Delta Junction, Alaska,

Nancy and I are grateful for all your prayers and support. We appreciate all that each and every one of you do for us. We are so thankful to God for His faithfulness, His safety and His wonderful peace and comfort.

God has continued to give us opportunities to minister not only here in Delta Junction but in Tok, Alaska as well. Tok is a community about 110 miles east of Delta Junction. It is the first community you reach when driving the Alaska Highway from Canada and about 1200 people live there. I had the opportunity to preach there at Gateway Baptist Church for Pastor Nicholas Sawyer for two Sunday's while he was in the lower 48. We are truly thankful for all the opportunities God gives us to carry the Gospel to the lost and to minister to His people. The Greatland Baptist Church here in Delta under, the leadership of Pastor Cliff Henry, is going well. We work out of the church and minister to shut-ins and others in the community as well. We still minister to those in the fire department and EMS service. God has also given me opportunities to fill-in for other ministries in other parts of the interior of Alaska. Lord willing in December we will fly to Cordova, Alaska to fill-in for the Bourdess family when they take a short furlough. We pray every day that God will give us opportunities to serve Him and help us to be a blessing and an encouragement to someone each day.

So many that we are trying to help have family needs or are facing attacks against their families. For many of these, the main issue is a spiritual need. They have no desire for God. Money and material things seem to be their god. That, and other things, has destroyed their families. We are so burdened for these families and know that only God can change their hearts. We continue to love them and be that witness in front of them, but we cannot condone their sin and must, in love, take a stand against it. I realize that what is taking place here with families is no different from where you live. But in a small town like Delta, when a family is having difficulty it seems to affect a lot of people in the community. If these individuals would get saved, what an impact that would have on other families as well! Please pray with us for opportunities to witness to them.

Please continue to pray for Bobby. He still has not gotten saved but we continue to see him and share Bible lessons with him. He stands in great need, not only spiritually, but physically as well. His health has turned for the worst. Please continue to pray for him. Continue to pray for Michael and Jonathan as well - for their spiritual needs and for the many more here in the community to whom we are ministering.

My heart is especially heavy for the first responders here in Delta Junction and I ask you to please keep them in prayer. So many of them are struggling with memories of past incidents to which they have responded. Some are reminded almost daily of those calls. When living in a small town, as I mentioned earlier, there are constant reminders of past situations when the responders see people that were involved, or family members that were affected by those tragedies. Pray for us as we seek to help these individuals through these difficult times and show them love and compassion.

Several have asked about our truck. It has over 383,000 miles now and needs over \$5000 dollars of repairs for tie rods, ball joints, alignment, rear breaks as well as a set of new tires. We praise the Lord that our home church, McLeansville Baptist Church, is sending a love offering to help cover the expense of these much needed repairs. We thank the Lord for them and their loving care for us. Please pray for us as we travel that the truck will be dependable and that we can continue to use it for His honor and glory.
