Greetings from Cordova, Alaska,

As we end another year and begin a new one, we can look back and see how God has worked in our own lives as well as the lives of many others over the past 12 months. It has been a privilege to be able to serve the Lord in Alaska for 23 years, mainly in Delta Junction and other parts of the Interior of Alaska. The people of Delta Junction are dear to our hearts and we continue to have a real burden for them and are looking forward to ministering there as long as the Lord leads. As we end 2019, we have had several opportunities to assist other ministries that needed help as the pastor or missionary took a short furlough to visit family or take care of other needs. God has given us the opportunity to be able to go and help these works. As I write this letter, we are in Cordova, Alaska filling in for the Bourdess Family as they take a short furlough to visit family in the lower 48. We arrived on December 12th and Lord willing we will return back to Delta Junction, Alaska on February 4th. While we are here, I will be preaching and we will also be leading the Patch the Pirate Clubs on Friday afternoons. Even though we are still in Alaska, it is totally different here than it is in the Interior of Alaska. Compared to all the rain we have been getting here since we arrived, Delta Junction seems like a desert. We are used to the dry cold of the interior. This damp weather feels colder even though the temperature here is almost 60 degrees warmer than it has been in Delta over the past week or so. Please keep us in your prayers as we minister here that we will be a help and an encouragement to the church family and a witness here in the community.

Please also continue to pray for Pastor Cliff Henry and the Greatland Baptist Church there in Delta Junction and the church family. Pray also for those to whom we minister on an almost weekly and sometimes daily basis there in Delta Junction. We still stay in contact with many of them as we serve here in Cordova. We have a special request for prayer. Two days before Christmas there was a fire in an apartment complex in Delta Junction. The whole complex was destroyed and several families lost everything. Please pray for these families and all those that were involved. We know the community will come together to help these families. It is our prayer that God will get the glory through it.

We truly appreciate everyone that has given towards the truck repairs. Many of the repairs have been completed and we have new tires. Several other repairs, Lord willing, we will get done after we return back to Delta in February.

Please continue to keep our health needs in prayer. I thank the Lord that my neck and hands have not been bothering me as much. It has been a blessing not to be having the pain and discomfort as well as other complications. Please continue to keep Nancy in prayer. She will have her 6-month followup on February 21st. Please pray that she will get another good report, if it be God's will.

We want to thank all of you for all your prayers and financial support. We are truly grateful for all that you do for us and we are truly thankful. We pray that God will bless you greatly in the New Year and use you greatly as well for His honor and glory.
