Over the 15 days of our journey home God protected us from the most severe storms that were numerous in the Midwest as we traveled. We had no break downs nor tire problems nor windshield cracks either. We praise the Lord for His grace and mercy. At each motel where we stayed, we left a Bible along with a thank you tract. One morning as we were packing the vehicle to leave, a lady came out with the Bible thinking that we had forgotten it. When we told her it was a gift, she held it close to her heart and thanked us.

It is good to be back in Alaska and to be with the people to whom God has called us. Pastor Cliff and his family as well as the wonderful people of Greatland Baptist Church welcomed us back. We have seen Bobby several times and have called him almost every day since returning. He still stands in need of prayer for his physical needs, but his spiritual need is the greatest. He seems to be listening more and allows me to pray with him more than in the past. I have been able to visit with the medics in Glennallen several times since being back. Please keep these medics as well as the ones here in Delta and the area firefighters in prayer as well. A lot has changed with the First Responders and the departments since we left. Please pray for this situation as more changes may be coming soon. These changes may affect how I will be able to minister to these groups in the future.

We appreciate all your prayers during our time in the lower 48 dealing with family needs and as we traveled visiting some of our supporting churches. There are so many churches that were there for us when we needed uplifting. Some of the churches were small in number but bountiful in grace. It was a blessing to worship together with them. Many gave large amounts to help with work and travel expenses.
