I get frustrated when things do not move as quickly as I believe they should, but God is patient with me, and continues to work with me teaching me to wait on Him. He knows all about our trials and what we think are delays that are really planned events by Him. He knows what needs to be done and when. He has constantly been faithful through it all and will always be faithful. He has proved it time and time again.

Our staying in North Carolina longer has given us the ability to travel and visit some supporting churches and be in many new churches as well. Praise the Lord for the new supporters and prayer partners of the work in Alaska. We are so thankful for all the new Pastors and church families that we have met. They have been a great blessing and an encouragement to us, and many have given special offerings to help with the expenses of traveling back to Alaska.
