Dear Praying Friends,

The Lord provided the way to spend the month of July with our children in Palau and Yap. It was wonderful to see first hand their works and to be able to preach for them in their various churches and Bible Studies.

In Palau we went with John to a basket ball tournament. He had 28 people in his truck, two or three times that many came, and one was saved after the challenge. It was a blessing to hear John preach in Palauan and challenge the young people and their sponsors. After the clean up some locals came and wanted to see who preached because he spoke with such an accurate accent. The week we spent there went by too quickly. John took us out fishing and we caught a few white snappers, which we ate for breakfast.

Then we spent 5 days at Paul's area. I was able to preach to a group in Ruu on Saturday night and the Sunday morning at Faith Baptist Church in Gagil. Opal was able to give her testimony to several ladies meetings and one Sunday School class.

Then we spent 5 days with Mark. Sunday night I preached in Yap Baptist Church, after several specials done by different groups of singers from other islands, and from Yap also.

Mark took us out beyond the reef and we reeled in two blue marlines in three hours. It was a team effort as Paul was also with us. We have never seen anything like that, It is no easy thing to bring in a marlin! God gave us beautiful weather the sea was like glass. Much of the fish was given to the people in their different areas, and they had plenty for themselves too.

It was wonderful to see the boys' ministries. We also were able to visit with Paul Yanruw's Mother who lives in Palau and then we were able to meet his Dad who lives in Yap. I showed his parents some pictures and they were so proud of their son. Paul is one of my students here at Calvary Baptist Bible College.

We did get to do some sight seeing both in Palau and Yap. I was especially interested in some WWII sights on both islands.

We are back in Puerto Rico now teaching another school year. Opal is teaching art again and serving as the librarian. I am teaching Hebrew, English 101, remedial English, and English as a second Language, plus working some air conditioning and refrigeration.

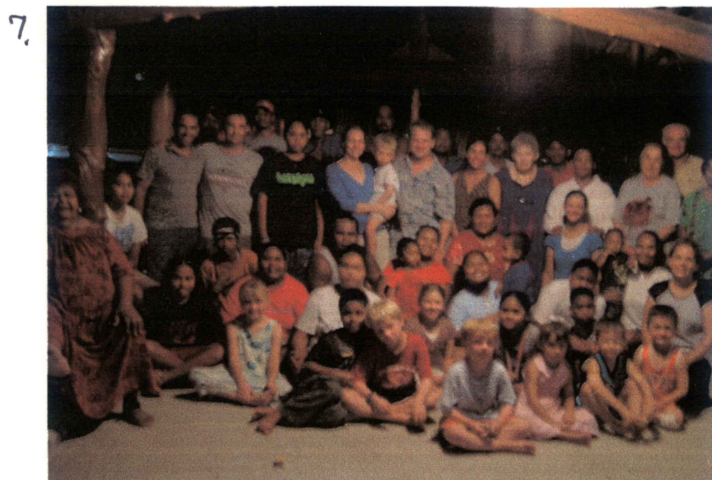
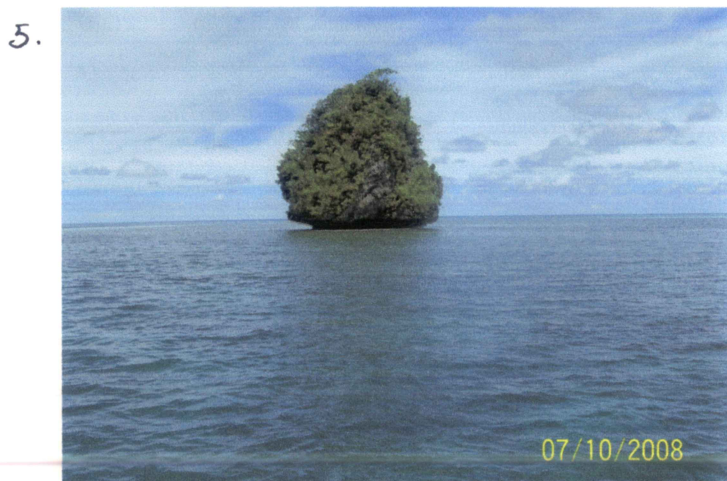
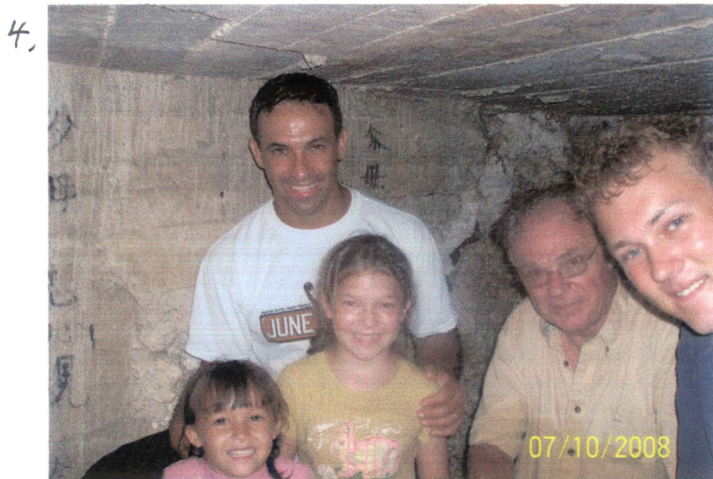

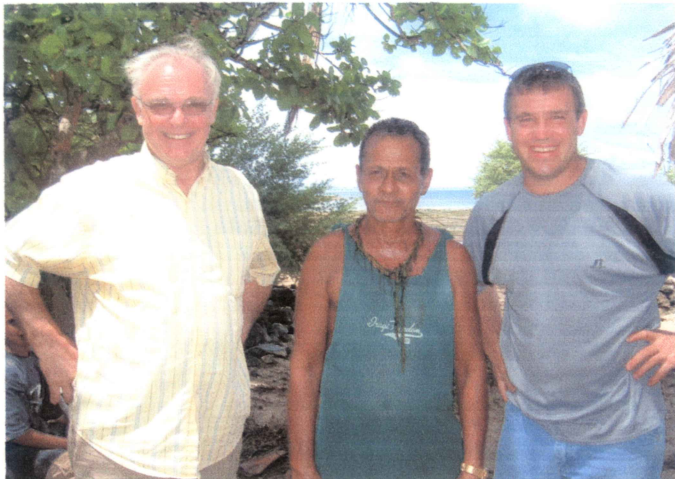

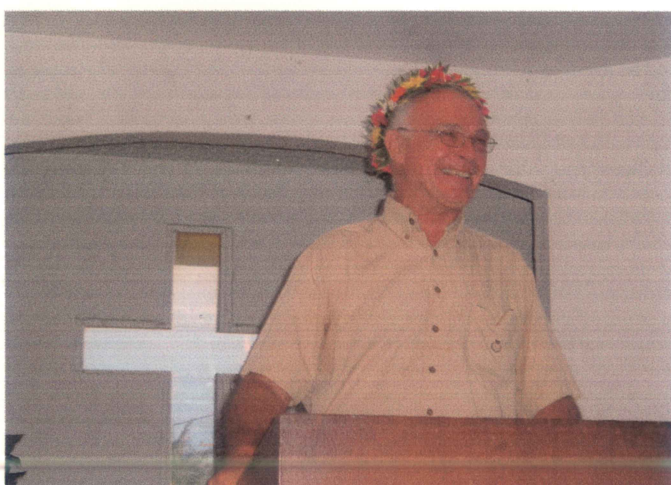

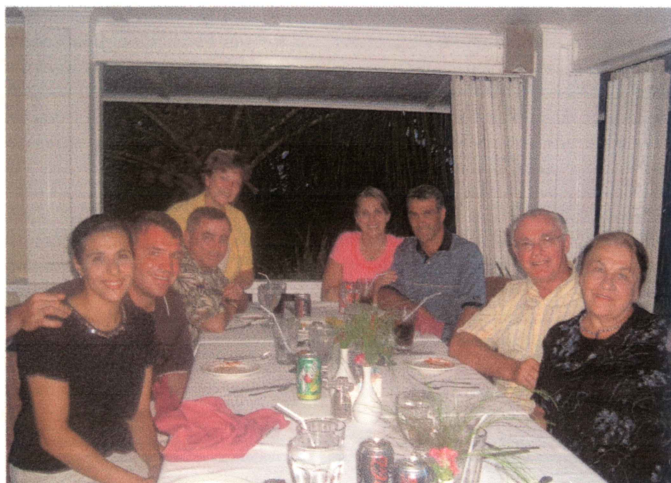

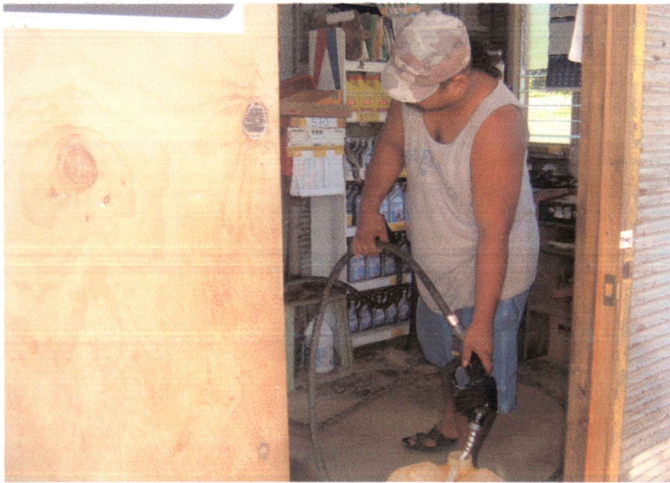
