We just finished the FBF(Caribbean) Conference and renewed acquaintances of several friends and former students and discussed several future trips to the Islands for block classes; Dominican Republic, Haiti, Granada, and Barbados. Since I teach in the morning and Wednesday evenings, Lord willing, I should be able to resume writing my Doctoral Thesis this year, having already completed all class work.

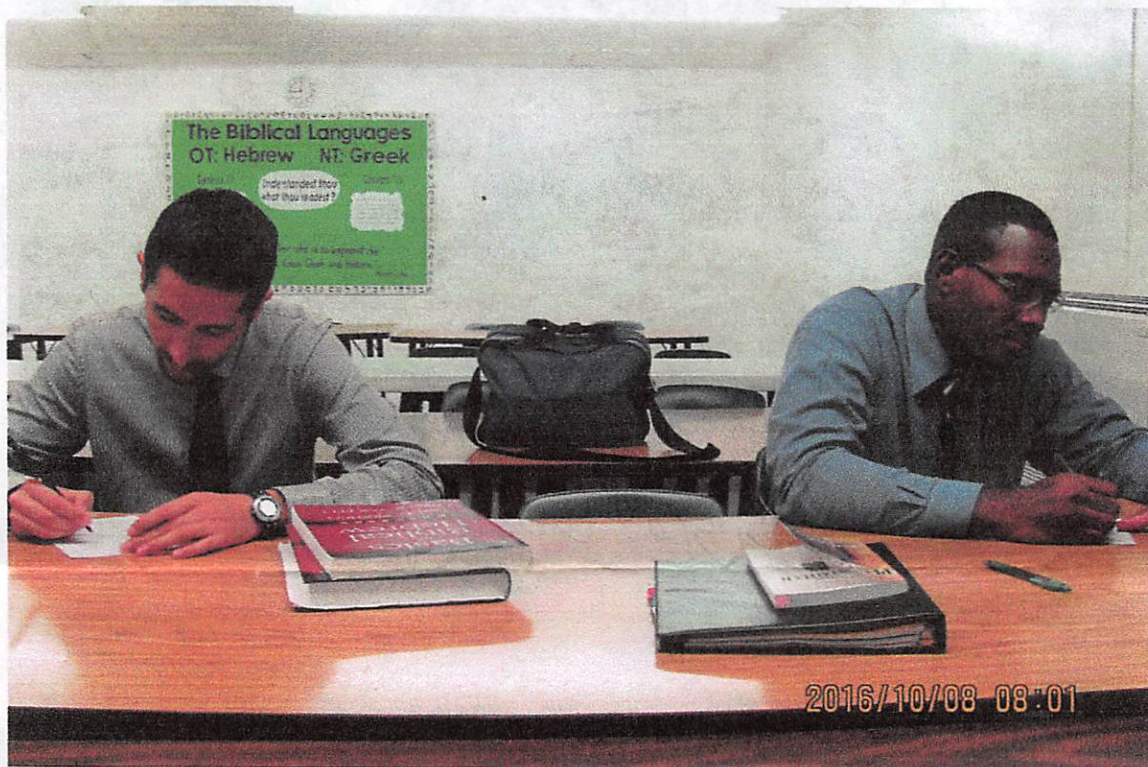

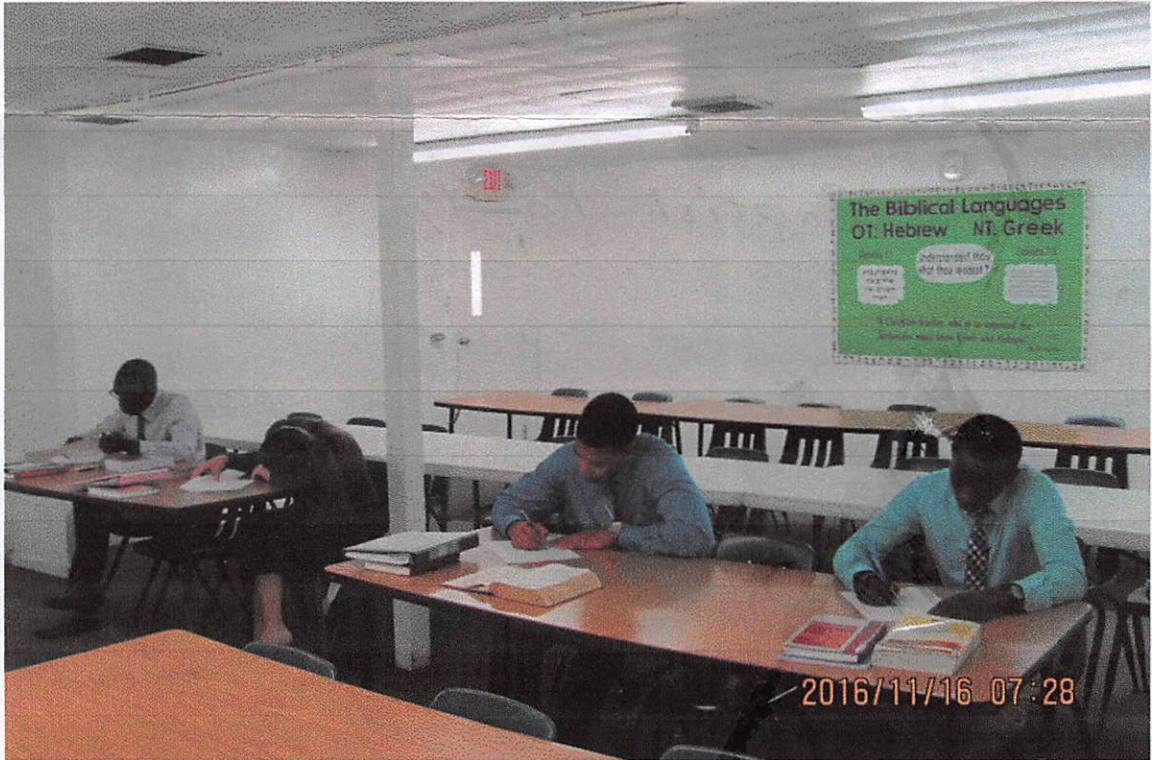
