Feb 1-7 Mark With Zimmer at Yap Baptist Church

Opal spoke to the ladies on Wednesday night service and I spoke to the men. On Sunday I spoke and gave testimony of Gods provision at the Sunday service.

I helped of Mark mill mahogany wood for a woman's meeting house as the termites had destroyed most of the cabinets, doors, and frames.



Also I repaired the saw mill when it broke down by welding and repairing blade guides. Then Mark needed a frame to hang a 75 pound video projector in the church auditorium, which I fabricated, hung and powered.

Opal taught art classes to Jr. High and High School and several lower class 5- 6 th grades, and spoke to the women's Sunday School class.

I gave my testimony to the High School assembly, of salvation and God's protection in Viet Naam, and 5 girls accepted Christ.

Repaired Gear teeth of cement mixer

A few years ago Paul started a Christian school for troubled teens that had been expelled from the government schools. They now have 154 students with many waiting to get in. As a result he began building for 450, which now should be ready for next school year.

When we got there, he needed to have 5 cement mixers ready to go but only one was working. I was able to service and repair all of these and Paul was able to finish the 3rd floor (a power room and library)

Feb 14-21 With John Zimmer with “Anchored in the Word” Bible Church of Palau.

Flew to Palau, 400 miles from Yap.



I spoke to the evening service at the church and afterwards 2 girls accepted Christ, and a lady that owned a hair salon asked me to give my testimony to her 14 Philippine employees. They were very attentive and they are continuing with a Bible Study by John every Monday morning.

I helped John in replacing 2 main posts that supported the roof of his church's meeting place by jacking up the roof and replacing the supports because of termite damage. Also repaired several roof leaks and helped clean the solar panels of mold as they were not producing 100%

Finally, when Paul finishes the electrical at the school, and mounts the AC indoor and outdoor units, we will go back for start-up of 23 AC units, making sure the Freon pressures are correct. I do have an AC & R license. It looks like it will be some time this winter that we will go back to finish the job.

We are thankful to offer a helping hand to each one of these thriving ministries. We praise the Lord for His goodness, safety, and being able to be a blessing. Thank you again for your prayers and continued support.
