We were incredibly blessed to have my mom and dad come for a visit in July. Our time with them was so short, but in the 5 days that they stayed with us, we made many wonderful memories. They spent 5 days with Paul and his family as well as John and his family in Palau. My dad preached in each of our churches and the people loved seeing my parents. They enjoyed spending time with 13 of their grandchildren and even doing a bit of fishing!

### **Prison Ministry**

The prison ministry is going well and the men seem to be getting more involved in the service. Several have indicated that they have accepted the Lord. We started singing some hymns and I play the ukulele for an accompaniment. I was very encouraged to have one of the men who was released 2 weeks ago join our Sunday service for 2 Sundays in a row now. We are trusting the Lord that he will continue to stand strong for the Lord. Last week as I was leaving the prison, I heard one of the men singing "Amazing Grace" to himself and was impressed with the potential that each of these men have for God's kingdom. Another prisoner told me that the men are starting to read a chapter of the Bible before lockdown. God's Word will accomplish it's purpose: to point men to Christ!

### **Bible Studies**

God opened a door to start a Bible study with our neighbors who are Kosrean. They have come to our church occasionally, but now Jackson and Jack were interested in studying the Bible with Roland and me. We had two morning sessions last week and we plan to continue this effort to see the Gospel work in their hearts.

On Sunday nights I have been meeting with another man recently saved and going through the "Basics for Believers" book with him. Please pray for George and his family that they will grow and be faithful in following the Lord.

Another extended family in our church has asked that I come to do a Bible study with their family and others in their village. Please pray that God will work in the hearts of these people and draw more to following Him.

We are starting a Wednesday night prayer service for adults in our church to give us the opportunity to get together and pray for each other and the lost here in Yap. Won't you also pray with us that God will soften the hearts of the Yapese people and show them their need for Christ?

### **Construction Project**

Patwin, Edwin, Roland and I finished putting in windows, roofing, and siding his kitchen addition several weeks ago. Recently, we installed some wallboard on the ceiling and walls and put in a light and sink. The

hardware store was having a sale and we purchased all the wallboard plus a front door for 20% off. God had impressed it on someone's heart to give Roland \$250 toward his project, and guess what? All the wallboard plus the door was just under \$250. This was a real faith building experience for all of us.
