We were also able to **install 24 solar panels on our church building.** My brother Paul brought a crew of guys over, and we assisted them in putting up the panels as Paul wired them in. We now have a large 6KW system that is helping with the extremely expensive power bill. Praise the Lord for gifts and abilities

We have helped with the block laying, setting forms, pouring the cement floor, as well as pouring the beam. A team came from Greenville, SC, and we worked together to pour the slab. It was a 2 day struggle against the rain, heat, and exhaustion! All the cement was mixed by using cement mixers and then pushed in wheel barrows to be poured. It is very labor intensive work, so we asked for volunteers, and both churches brought men together to help with the work.

God provided some huge trees for our project right in our back yard! Our village chief gave us the trees, and so last week some of the church guys helped as Paul and I cut 7 Gumar trees and about 10 Mahogany. We need the wood for
